Each cell in Excel is part of a row and a column. Rows are designated with numbers (1, 2, 3, etc.) shown along the left side of the spreadsheet, while columns are designated with letters (A, B, C, etc.) shown along the top. To refer to a cell, use the column letter and row number together, such as A1 or W22 (the column letter always comes first).

Remember, all formulas in Excel must begin with an equal sign (=). Use parentheses to ensure certain calculations are done first. For example, consider how =10+10\*10 is different than = (10+10)\*10. In addition to manually typing in simple calculations, you can refer to Excel's built-in formulas.

Perform basic operations. You can add, subtract, divide, and multiply cell values with the following formulas: Add — Type =SUM (cell+cell) (e.g., =SUM (A3+B3)) to add two cells' values together, or type { (kbdj)=SUM (cell,cell,cell) (e.g., =SUM (A2,B2,C2)) to add a series of cell values together.
